



## TRADESTATION GROUP NAMED ONE OF THE “100 BEST CORPORATE CITIZENS”

### 2007 Annual Survey Focuses on Corporate Responsibility Performance of Major U.S. Companies

These firms are ranked on service in eight stakeholder categories: shareholders, community, governance, diversity, employees, environment, human rights, and product.

Now in its 8th year, the “100 Best Corporate Citizens” list identifies companies that excel at serving a variety of stakeholders well. The 100 Best Corporate Citizens list was developed by *Business Ethics* magazine, which was incorporated last year into The CRO ([www.thecro.com](http://www.thecro.com)), a premier membership organization for Corporate Responsibility Officers.
